



Tuckers Maltings have been turning Barley into Malt since 1831, moving from Ashburton to the Newton Abbot site during 1900. A special beer was commissioned for the 2000 Beer Festival to honour the man who chose the new home - John Parnell Tucker. This is now the only traditional working Malthouse open to the public.

In 1993 The Maltings hosted the 1st SIBA (Small Independent Brewers Association*) Beer Festival. When I first attended in 1994 with my old mate Rod Wilmot there were 90 beers. A festival like no other. A great setting, a great train ride to get there, and an ever growing number of West Country beers – 250 in 2006! An annual event to be attended come what may! A concept that's been readily accepted by friends old and new across the years. With the indulgence and support of my old friend Neil Beverley, this became a regular fixture for a group of like minded souls who set off on their 1st adventure in 1999. The group has blossomed from the original 6 Musketeers of 1999 to a gathering of some 30 friends by 2010. Names for the Group have been bandied around, but like SIBA itself we couldn't find one to fit. Suffice to say - "We will be there!" and each year we endeavour to expand the group and capture it all in the obligatory Group Photo. Where would we be without Official Photographer - Terry Knott. 




